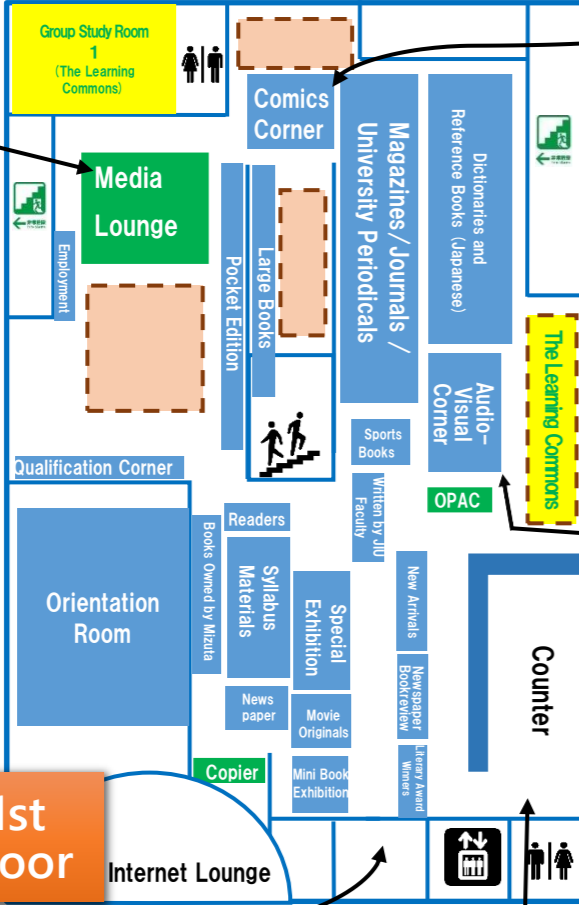


Media Lounge

Comics and reference books cannot be checked out. Please use them within the library. The latest issues of periodicals cannot be checked out, but back issues can be checked out.

Audio-Visual Corner

There are audio-visual materials (DVDs, VHS etc.) available in the library. Please apply at the counter when using them. TV sets are also available for use.

For individual use only. Please apply at the counter when you wish to use it. A key will be provided upon registration.

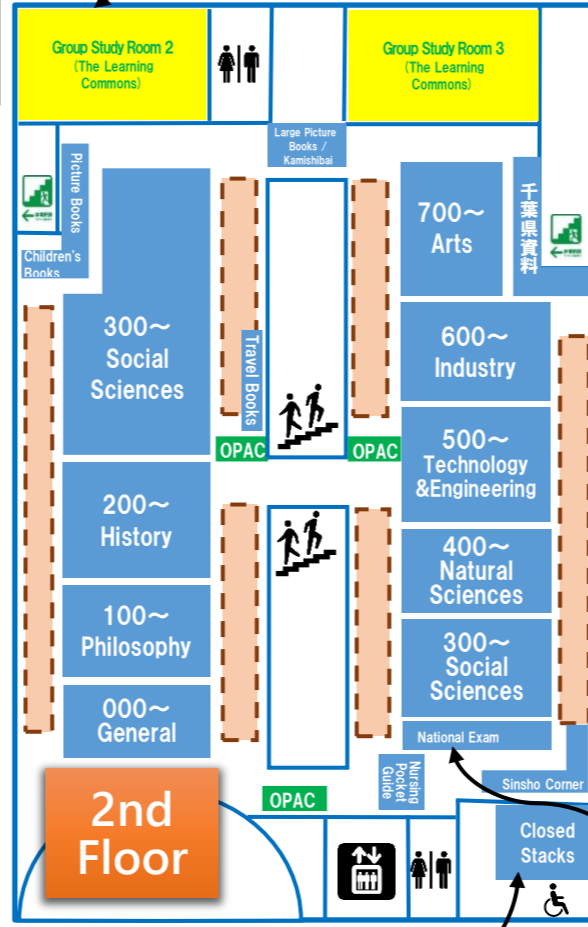


1st Floor

Closed Stacks

Materials with the location marked “閉架書庫” (eng. closed stacks) are stored in the closed stacks room. Back issues of journals and older books are kept there. Please ask at the counter if you wish to use them.

OPAC Computers

OPAC is the system for searching materials in our library. You can check the location of books on the shelves. OPAC computers are available on each floor. You can also access OPAC from your own computer or smartphone, not just from library terminals.



Counter

The counter handles check-out and check-in of items, as well as requests to use PCs and audio-visual materials. We also provide document delivery and interlibrary loan service, and issue letters of introduction for visiting other universities.
